

Regional and rural development trends over the last forty years – RKK40 Anniversary conference

Rural/agrotourism has been one of the main diversification methods for agriculture in Europe and elsewhere. After the 90-s political change of CEE countries an interesting rural/agrotourism supply emerged which was partly similar, partly different from the Western, Southern and Northern European patterns.

How the generation change took place and how the new generation took over this very special family/farm based activity? How rural/agrotourism development special country characteristics?
